### A golden milestone for Silver Lake Resources

GOLDFIELDS gold producer Silver Lake Resources recently poured its 100th gold bar since production started from the Lakewood processing facility earlier this year.

Silver Lake managing director Les Davis said more than one record was achieved that week when the company poured the milestone bar.

"Not only did we pour the 100th gold bar, we also achieved record daily and weekly production during the week as well" Mr Davis said.

He said 275 fine ounces of gold was achieved through the gravity circuit from 24 hours milling, which calculated to 28g per tonne gold head grade for the day.

During the week, the company poured a total of 60kg of bullion.

The Lakewood processing plant, located 5km east of Kalgoorlie and 45km from Daisy Milano operation, was purchased by Silver Lake in December 2007.
