Daisy's first gold

SILVER Lake Resources is Kalgoorlie's newest gold miner after trucking the first ore from its Daisy Milano Mine yesterday.

"To go from an emerging gold producer to an actual gold producer in less than four weeks from taking ownership of the mine is an

exceptional achievement," Silver Lake managing director Les Davis said.

"It's a great day for Silver Lake, it's a great day for its employees and shareholders but more importantly a really great day for Kalgoorlie.

"It's a bloody good region; it's produced in excess of 60

million ounces of gold and we're going to contribute to that total."

The company will ramp up to 35,000 to 40,000oz per annum by June 2008.
